It might be a song lyric, or a movie scene, or a poem, or a painting that we love, to help us get a new angle into that question. So I can't wait to talk about the Rolling Stones, or Abraham Joshua Heschel, or who knows what else will come our way!

V: Oh my god, I can't wait for you to talk about the Rolling Stones [Casper laughs] or Heschel. [both laugh] I had no idea you had interests in these things.

C: So come join us on The Real Question. We'll always have one question, two friends, and no answers.

V: Our first episode will be coming out on March first, and then will come out every Monday after that. We hope you'll join us.
